### Curriculum Details

Curriculum type : Local

Curriculum planning

Our curriculum is compiled according children's life experience and ability. We structure our curriculum by adopting various theories such as intergrated curriculu, the project approach and multiple intelligences. We aim to inspire children's thinking ability and to foster their initiative for learning.

We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Learning / Teaching approach & activities

We put an emphasis on biliteracy and trilingualism. We let children learn English and Putonghua through play. The school offers various learning models, such as project-based learning, community visits and small-group activities, for children to learn in a happy environment. Community-collaboration plan - enriching child's life experience by bonding closely with our community. Learning through nature - child acquire healthy values and concrete knowledge by interacting with the flora and fauna around us, building genuine respect and appreciation for our mother nature.




Monthly salary range of principal & teaching staff
