We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Learning / Teaching approach & activities

We implement exploration, group learning, activity-based teaching and outdoor visits in accordance with pre-primary curriculum guidelines, which blend with young children's daily life experiences, interests and musical elements into teaching activities.

Assessment of children's learning experiences

"Children's learning portfolio", "Continuous Observation Records" and "Unit Evaluation Report" are used to assess children's language, Art and Creativity, Toddler Math, individuals and groups, Nature and life and technology, physical fitness and health development.

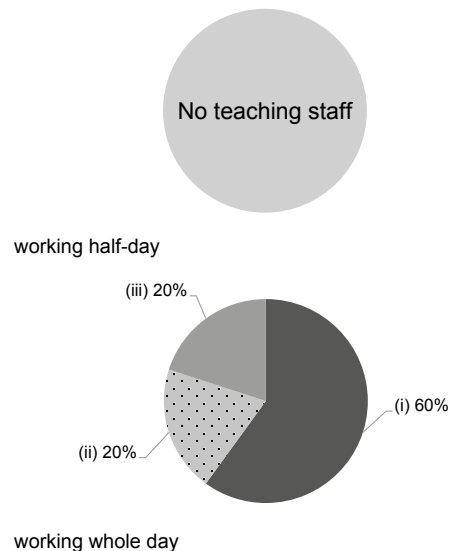

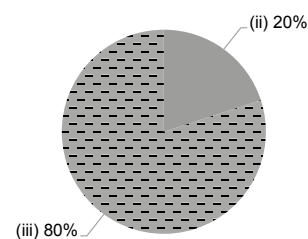
