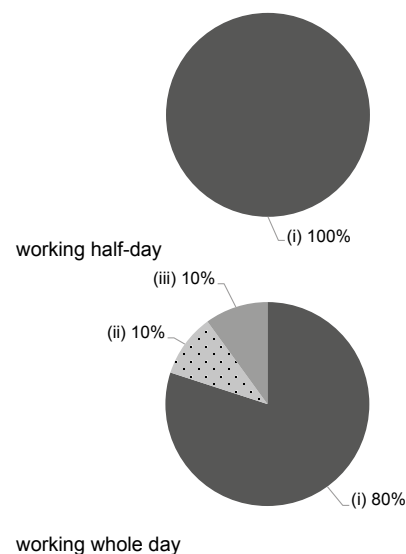

Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

Our story-based teaching approach is used for improving children's biliteracy and trilingualism levels. 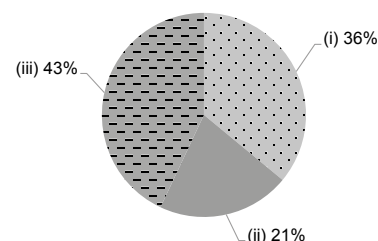

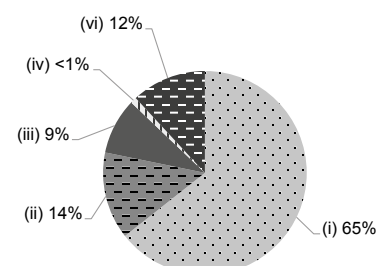
