We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Learning / Teaching approach & activities

Theme-based Teaching Approach: development in knowledge, skills and attitudes through activities, explorations and experiences. Bi-Literacy and Tri-Lingualism: create an effective language environment by native teachers. Moral Education: cultivate children's virtues of being filial and respectful and loving, communicate and share with others, and establish the values of self-esteem, self-confidence and positivity.

Assessment of children's learning experiences

We motivate children 'To learn from experience', so that children can learn from real-life and real-time experience. Reflections on activities, continuous Assessment on children's performance and children's works are pivotal tools for analysis on children's performance.
