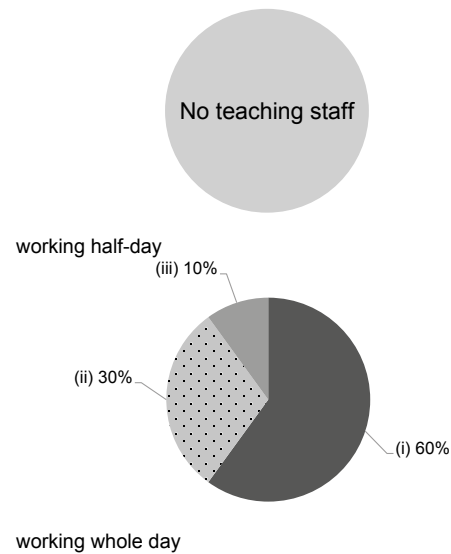
Curriculum Details

Drama-based approach, Orff music, shared reading programme are adopted to guide children to learn happily, so that the spirit of 'love to learn, skillful to communicate, ready to undertake responsibilities and eager to innovate is developed.

Children's performance in learning and physical and psychological developments are assessed on an ongoing basis throughout the school year by ways of extended and conclusive assessments.

We provide a nice environment based on the love of Jesus and the love-oriented and artistic education-oriented approaches. Social workers are employed for promoting the belief of 'happy parents happy children' through professional services. This is designed to enhance the family's function so children grow up healthily through home-school collaboration.

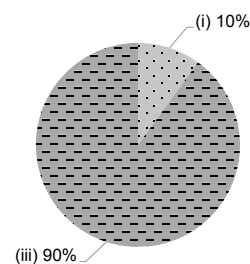
