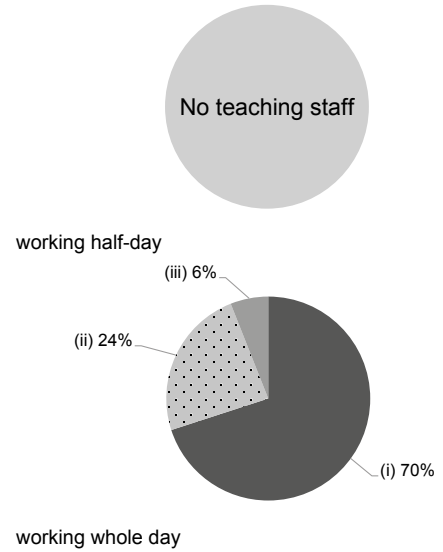

We are committed to nurturing children's moral development, arranging biblical and life education activities and holding a birthday party every month to create a caring campus. Enhancing children's cognitive and language skills through daily English language activities and regular outdoor visits. We provide different physical appliances for training children large and small muscle development so as children participate in physical activities every day since childhood to establish a good living habits; by music appreciation, singing, musical instruments and art activities, children play creative. 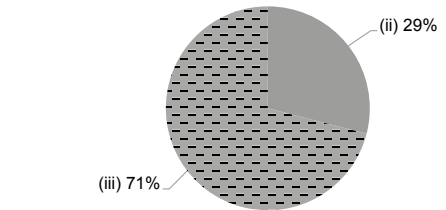

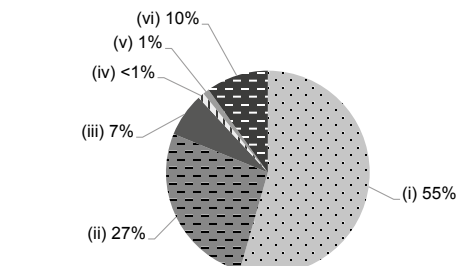
