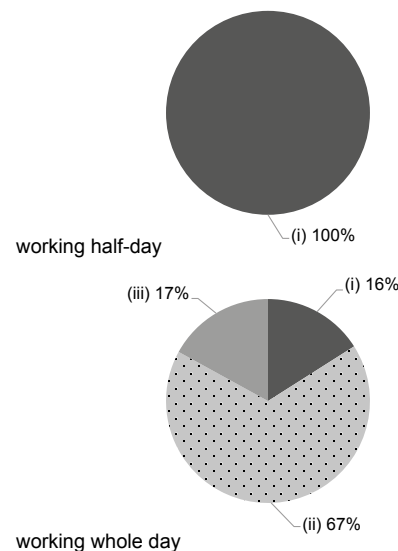

Through the Theme Approach, Free choice Corner Activities, Free Play, Dramatic Approach and Project Approach to enable children to learn effectively and happily.</p> <p>We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

<p>We enhance children's eagerness in learning by adopting teaching modes like theme-based teaching, project approach, free choice corners in order to provide different learning experience appropriate for children with diverse needs and interests. We aim to nurture child self-motivation, self-care, develop interest in exploration and problem solving skill through games and different activities</p>

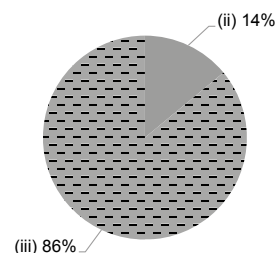

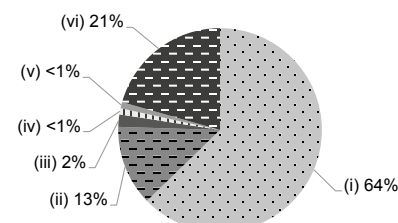
