Curriculum type: Local

Curriculum planning

The curriculum is formulated with reference to the Guide to Pre-primary Curriculum 2017 prepared by the Curriculum Development Council of the Education Bureau. The child-centred approach s adopted to enrich children's life experiences and stimulate development of potential through the learning process of asking questions, games, exploration and discovery.

We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Learning / Teaching approach & activities

Design a diversified learning area corner with lively and funny, activities with aim of enhancing children's active learning attitude. Moreover, it can enhances the development and growth of the students spiritually morally, academically, physically, socially and aesthetically through different learning mode, for example, drama, design activity, large and small group learning, experiment exploration, individual learning, cooperative teaching and visit experience, etc.

Assessment of children's learning experiences

Children's performance and progress in all aspects are recorded by way of ongoing observation. A report on student development is distributed annually. A profile on learning is kept for each student for report to the parents.

School Characteristics

School vision and mission

Support to students
