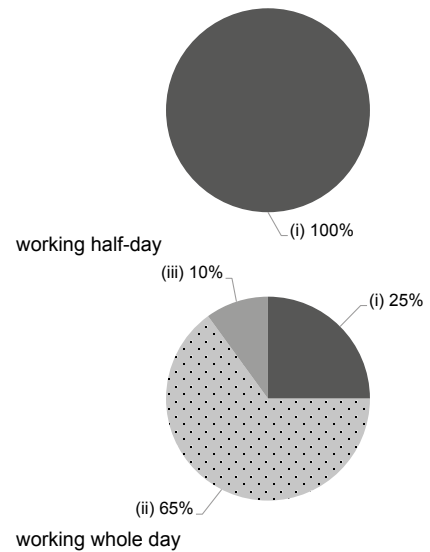

Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

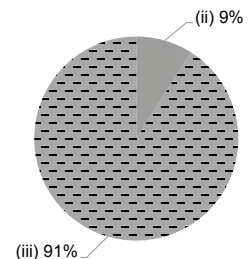
