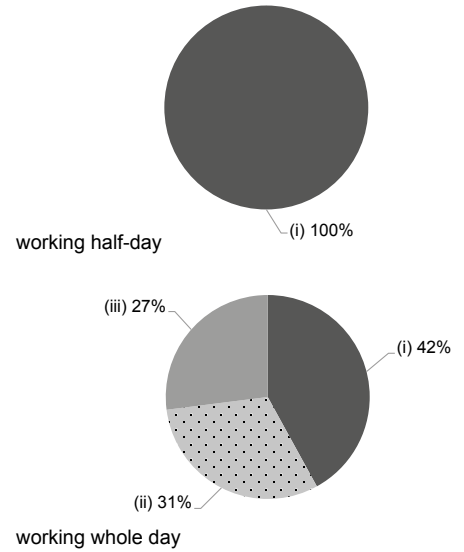

Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

<p>The quintessence of high scope, whole language and thematic approaches, specially-designed activities and Orff music is combined. Children are guided to realize the fun of self-directed learning through interactive group learning, making use of community resources, site visits and inviting professionals to give talks at the school.</p>

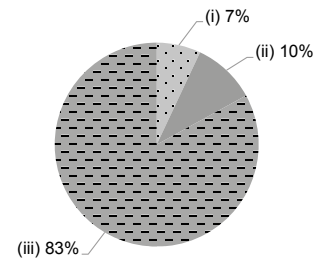

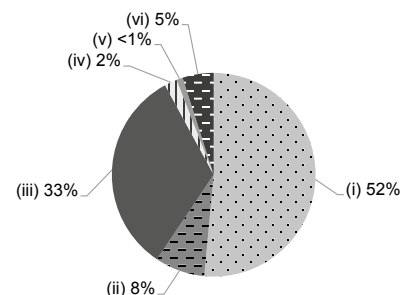
