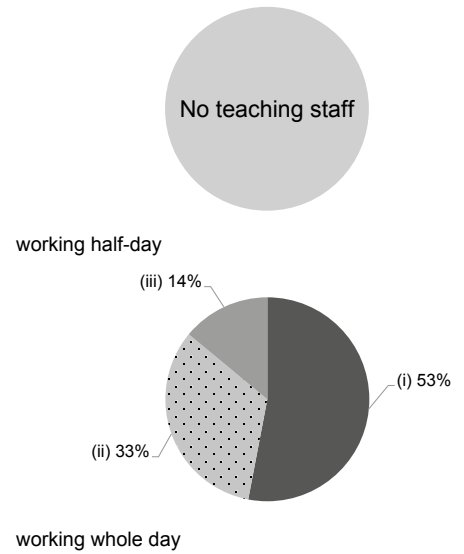

Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>	
Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
<p>Game elements, combined with life experiences, are incorporated in learning activities, which can stimulate children's motivation and interest in learning. Creating an interesting corner and environment with sensory exploration can encourage self-directed learning in children, which can foster problem-solving skills and diversified abilities in a growth mindset. At the same time, group activities, outdoor visits, storybook teaching, life education, mindfulness practices etc. allow children to gain more personal life experiences, which could help them to establish a positive and confident learning attitude.</p>

<p>We record children's learning progress through continuous observation and put together a comprehensive record of children's development in the "personal learning file".</p>

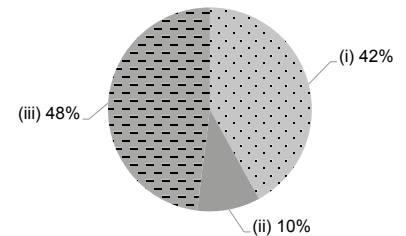

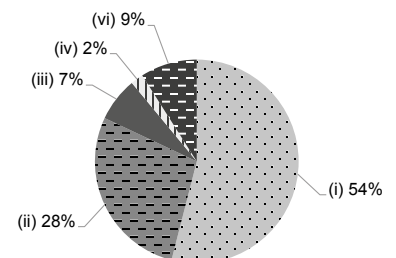
