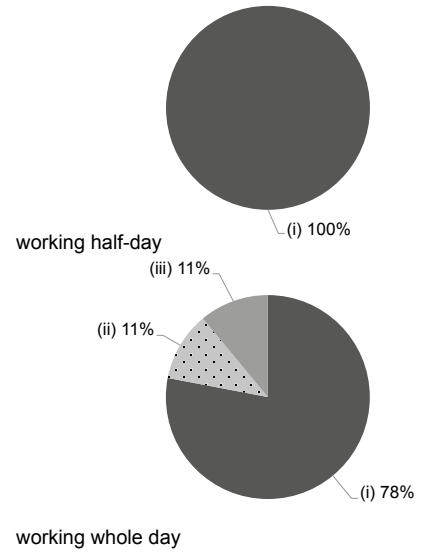

Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

<p>English activities are held by well-trained native English teacher. like group games, story telling and singing, learning phonics so as to strengthen students' abilities in listening, speaking, reading and writing in English. In addition, applying the themes of the curriculum into music games, art exploration, computer skills learning, physical training, scientific exploration, moral education, etc. enables the students to master the knowledge of various topics in an interdisciplinary form.</p>

<p>We record children's performance and development by observation report and continuous assessments. Regular parents meetings are held to help parents understand more about children's learning status in school.</p>

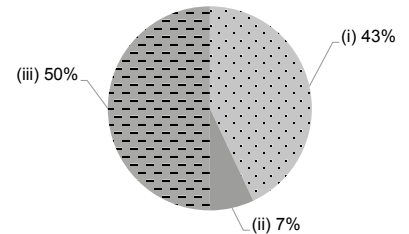

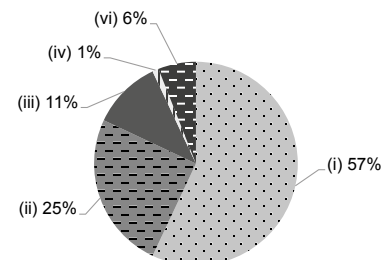
