We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Learning / Teaching approach & activities

We implement the "High Scope Module" that works in conjunction with extended learning activities, outings, interviews, research and various modes of learning.

Assessment of children's learning experiences

Continuous observations to monitor children's learning effectiveness. We regularly collect their work as samples for recording and analyze them in order to understand their development progress; before compiling such information onto a personal learning portfolio.

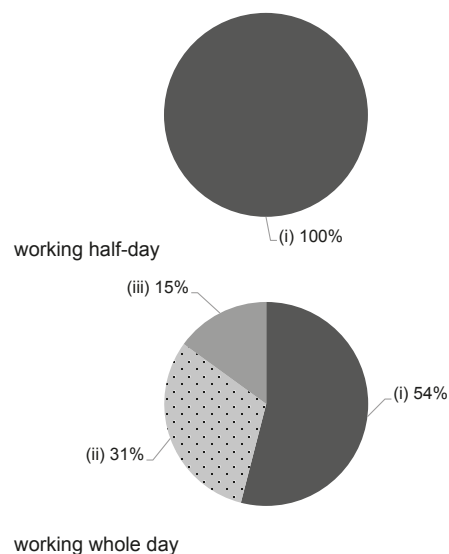

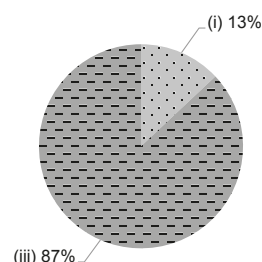
Monthly salary range of principal & teaching staff
