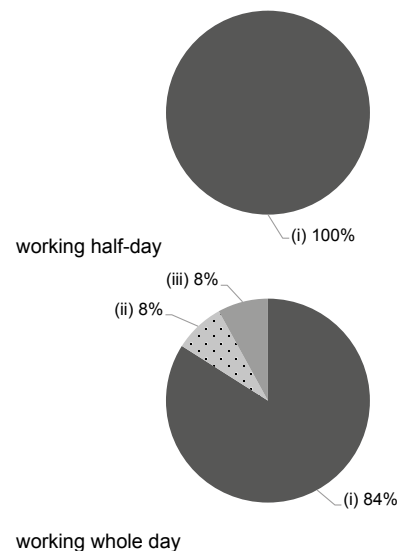

<p>We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

Learning in 6 major areas is provided: languages, early mathematics, art, science and technology, self and society, physical fitness and health. 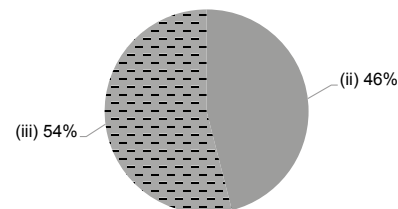
