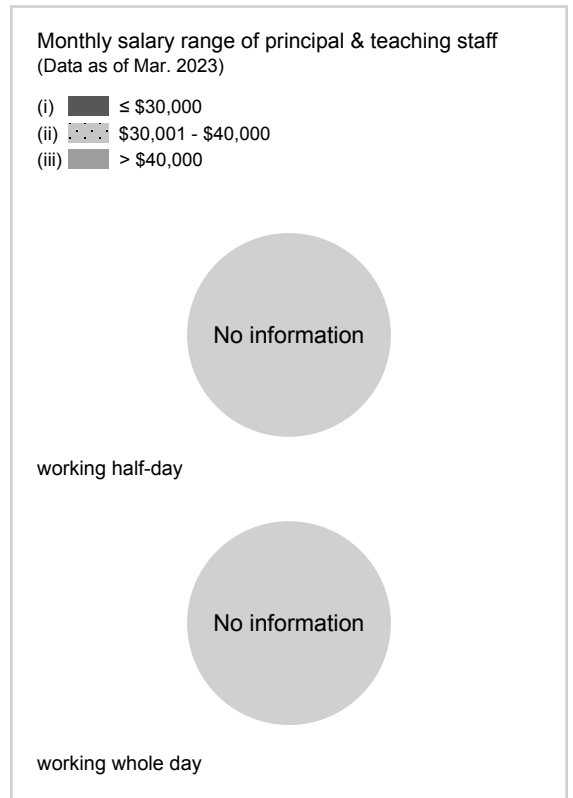

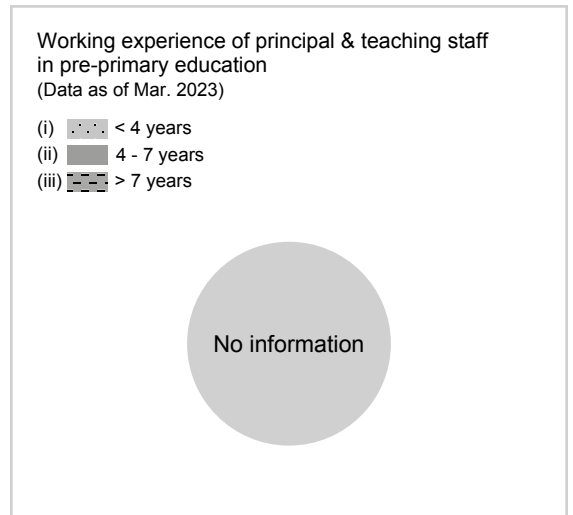

Teachers are constantly engaged in the children's play and support learning by asking open-ended questions and modelling vocabulary.
