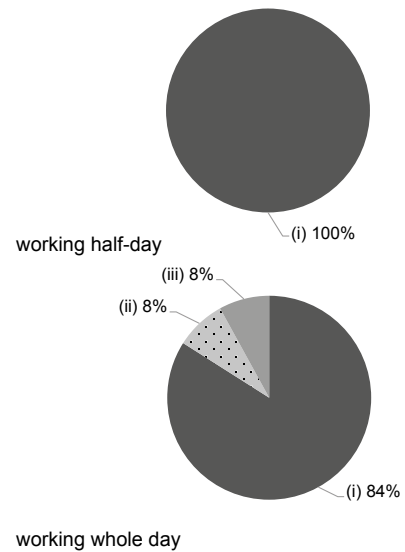

Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

<p>We enrich children learning experiences through a multimedia learning platform. We extend children's learning fields by adopting a project-based learning approach, and provide more exploring opportunities for children to enhance their problem-solving skills and cultivate their correct values. We arrange outdoor visits, simulation activities, group experiments, English Week, Mandarin Week, etc. to provide children an opportunity for life-wide learning.</p>

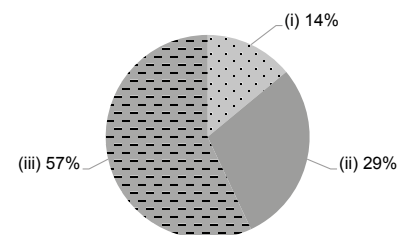

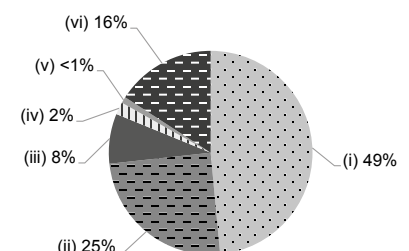
