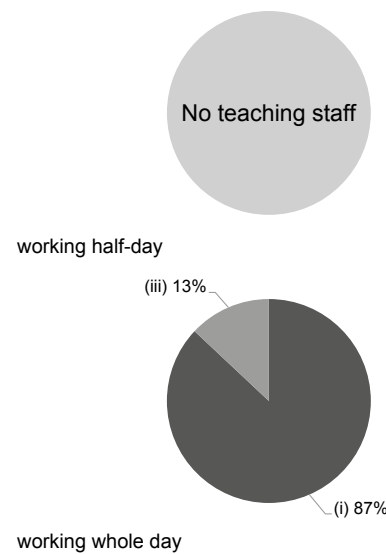

AIMS: *Encourage and help children to instill a positive attitude towards the acquisition of knowledge and understanding their world. *Assist children to develop their concentration power and observational analytical, reasoning and problem-solving skills. *Laying a good foundation of basic numeral knowledge. *Support and facilitate children's efforts to identify and express their thoughts and emotions linguistically.</p> <p>We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>	
Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
<p>Confidence, self-control, self-trust, determination, perseverance are attributes that we aim to instill in all our children for an enjoyable and productive future. These are traits that need nurturing with care, guidance, and loving encouragement, not repetition. We are mindful of this and implement it in every interaction and activity. Therefore, we offer a diverse and dynamic program that focuses on developing physical, social, emotional and intellectual skills of children.</p>	
Assessment of children's learning experiences	
<p>A monthly assessment of the previous month's theme, all of which is provided to the parents through checklists. Furthermore, all weekly themed activities are accumulated and presented to the parents twice a year. Every Friday they take home their creative work of the week.</p>

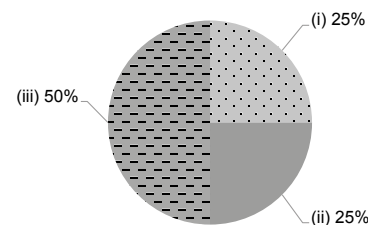
Monthly salary range of principal & teaching staff (Data as of Mar. 2023)
