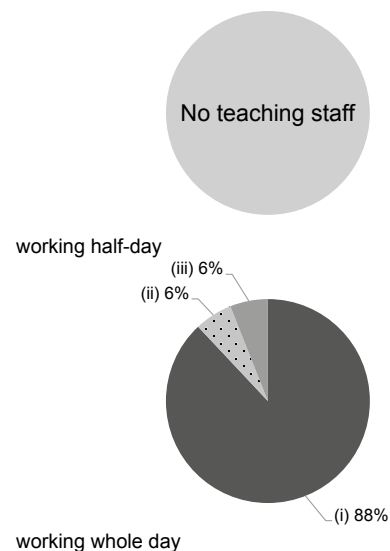

<p>Thematic teaching, Project Approach, Dramatic Approach, corner activity, site visits, group activities and mixed-age activities are all that can help children learn voluntarily through personal experience and repeated explorations.</p>

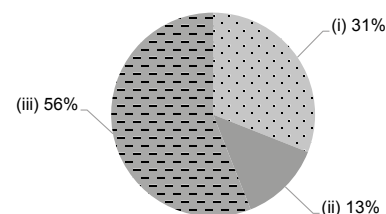
