<p>Our curriculum is designed to meet curriculum objectives of the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" and caters to children's interest in learning, covering moral, intellectual, language, social, aesthetic and spiritual areas; It focuses on enhancing children's biliterate and trilingual abilities through interest activities in Mandarin and English.</p> <p>We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>	
Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
<p>We adopt activity-based approach, and teach children with use of picture books. We offer extended activities that are related to the project-based learning methods. Children learn through games. Our integrated curriculum is designed based on children's life experience. We develop children's learning interest by organizing outdoor visits, and arrange extracurricular multi-intelligence activities, to develop potential and promote whole-person development of children.</p>
