Our school provides professional information and training on curriculum and teaching guided by educational psychologists. We design spiral-integrated, diverse, balanced and inspiring curriculum and activities to enrich and reinforce children's learning.

We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Our school's curriculum places emphasis on meeting the needs of children, and with appropriateness to daily living and the community, designs various levels of curriculum. Through methods such as storytelling, language, game teaching, free play, Montessori teaching philosophy, and systematic physical education, as well as creative aesthetics education that allows children to express their individuality, we inspire the overall development of children, and cultivate a proactive attitude towards learning and independence.

Assessment of children's learning experiences

Our school conducts ongoing observation, recording, and file analysis to assess children's development and learning. The assessment covers various aspects such as cognition, language, social skills, emotional development, and physical ability.
