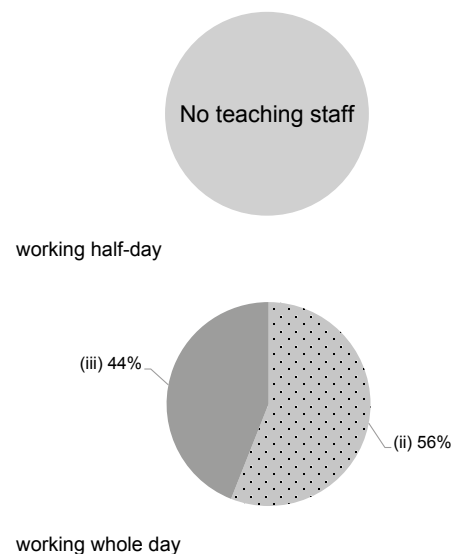

Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

<p>Our curriculum caters to children's needs. Considering environments and community conditions, we design curriculums of all levels. By using stories, a whole language learning environment and life training activities, we help children to achieve all-round development, and cultivate their initiatives and independence in learning.</p>

<p>Children's development and learning assessments are conducted through continuous observations, records and portfolios which cover their all-round development in cognitive, language, social, emotional, physical and other aspects.</p>

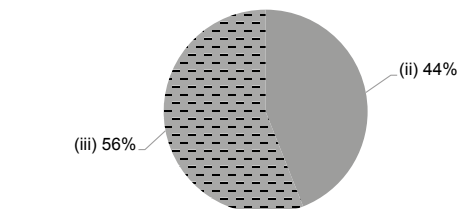
