Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

<p>According to children's interests, abilities and experience, as well as things related to children's life, our school curriculum formulates appropriate comprehensive courses, including: "design activities", "thematic learning" and "picture book teaching", allowing children to observe, discuss, Construct learning by means of operation, sharing and application. Promote children's learning motivation and learning spirit, enhance creativity and problem-solving ability, and develop inner potential.</p>	
Assessment of children's learning experiences	
<p>The assessment follows the principle of children's overall physical and mental development. Teachers and parents work together to record children's performance and abilities in all aspects through continuous observation, so as to understand children's growth.
