<p>Our curriculum is based on spiral approach with theme-based learning and integrated with project approach. It allows young learners to experience an independent learning experience, establish children's interest in learning, and enhance children's critical thinking, self-confidence, self-discipline and interaction in group discussions. We will allow students to explore out of the classroom and carry out a full range of learning experience activities according to the learning objectives of the monthly themes.</p>	
<p>We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>	
Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
<p>Young children learn through thematic instruction, project activities, games and integrated activities to develop their multiple intelligences. We attach importance to the development of children's language proficiency, thus designed a series of engaging activities for them to initiate preliminary exposure to both Mandarin and English through their mother tongue.</p>

<p>Our school performs continuous observation to assess children's performance and development that include: "Physical Fitness and Health", "Early Childhood Mathematics", "Nature and Living", "Self and Society" and "Art and Creativity".</p>

"Intellectual growth" relates to the importance of developing children's language and thinking for self-expression, and to groom their ability in solving problems.
