We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Learning / Teaching approach & activities

Design integrated curriculum, incorporate the elements of language and music into all the learning activities, provide comprehensive and interesting learning experience for children. Make good use of community resources, and participate in community activities to support and broaden children's learning experience, for example, visiting the Supermarket, Road Safety Town, Environmental Resource Centre, Brighter Smiles Playland", etc.

Assessment of children's learning experiences

Evaluate children's learning experience in the form of continuous observation, and record children's development in every aspect with different assessment tools, in order to establish Children Learning Portfolio, and to share regularly with parents.


