Curriculum planning

We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Our kindergarten adopts the story teaching method, where a complete learning scenario is created through a variety of interesting stories that make learning activities closely relevant to young children's lives in order to stimulate and enhance their interest in learning, and in the process cultivate their communication understanding, organization and communication skills.

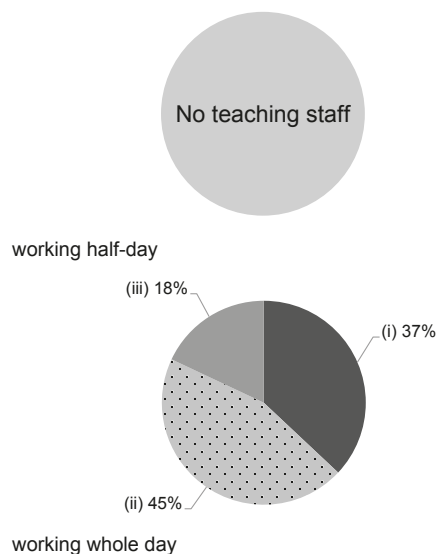

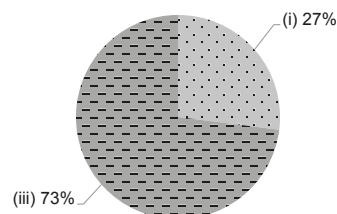
Monthly salary range of principal & teaching staff
