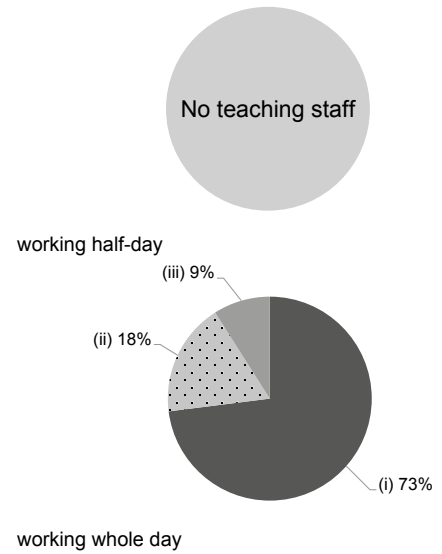

Children are also fostered the attributes of zeal for life, love for family and concern for the society.</p> <p>We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

The project-based approach, group activities and art activities are provided to create enjoyable, ambitious and creative learning environment. Children are aroused to pursue self-directed learning. 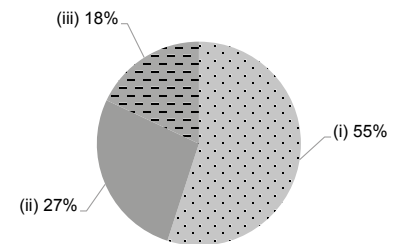
