Curriculum type : Local

Curriculum planning

The child-centered curriculum utilizes story units flexibly in designing activities with biliteracy and tri-lingualism, background arrangement and sensory exploration, so as to promote comprehensive development of children. In recent years, it places more emphasis on development of creativity by providing different opportunities and space for children to experience beauty and take part in creative activities.

We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Learning / Teaching approach & activities

1. Group learning, planning activities, community involvement, outdoor visits; 2. Employs English and Putonghua teachers specifically.

Assessment of children's learning experiences

1. Continuous observations are implemented on children's learning outcomes; 2. Establish children's learning portfolio to record children's growth

School Characteristics

School vision and mission

Education mission: Based on Christian faith, the nursery strives to nurture students to be courteous, honest, self-confident, happy with self-initiative to learn and good living habits so that their potentials can be developed to the full. The nursery provides diversified learning environment for children to explore and experience personally. Cultivate children with good characters and habits. Fully support parents and strengthen their parenting effectiveness, together with the social workers to provide professional counseling to parents.

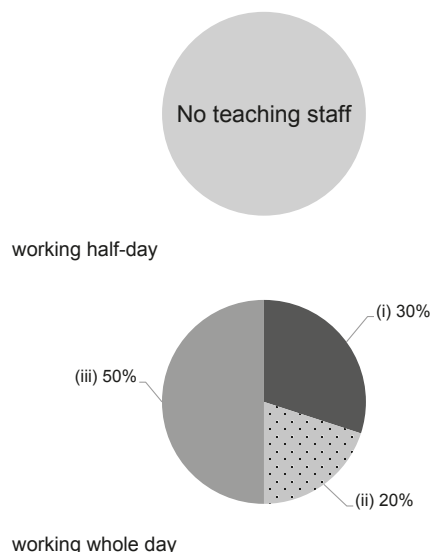

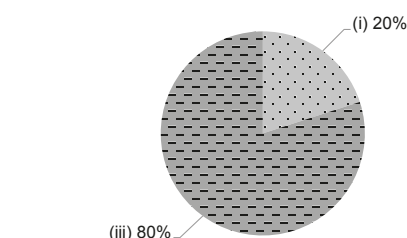
