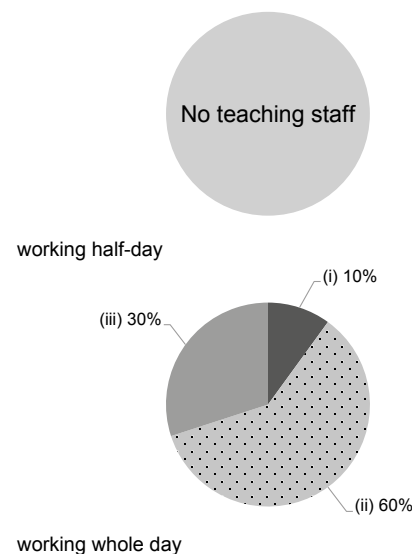

"The Student Development Report" is prepared in accordance with the child's age and development. In each semester we consult individually with parents to discuss learning and school life.</p>

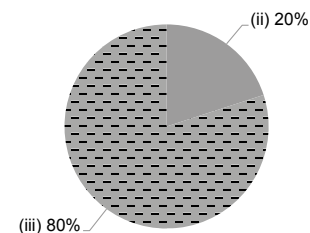
