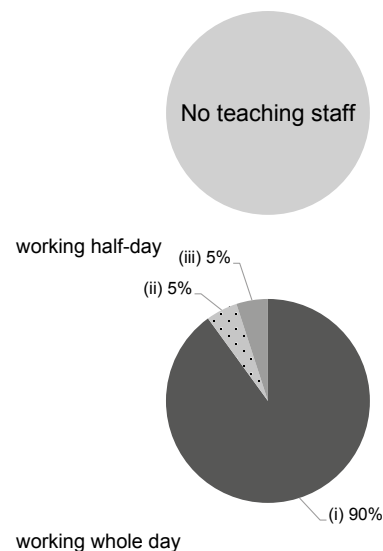

We develop our children's potentials through a variety of activities such as Montessori free choice time, experiential activities, themed activities, extracurricular activities, outing learning experiences, science experiments, and home visits.</p>

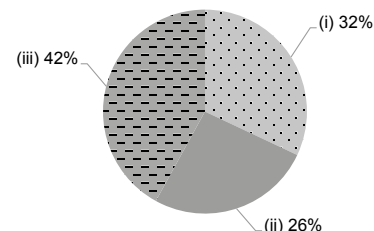
