These help to develop the child's decision making and problem-solving skills. STEAM classes are included to increase children's curiosity and their enjoyment in learning.

# Support to students

We co-operate with our parents thoroughly to get to know our students better in order to give utmost support for the children. New students will have a 'warm-up' week, so students and parents can understand the daily lifestyle at Nobel. Extra-curricular classes are offered, such as English, Putonghua and STEAM, as well as dance and playgroups, to further develop our students' interests and experiences. For upper-grade students going into Primary School, they are given interview classes and school visits. Information talks are also provided for parents to inform them of application procedures and tip and skills of getting into their chosen primary school.




