<p>The Montessori curriculum provides a child centred approach that promotes independence and a true love of learning. Each child's unique spirit, sense of wonder and deep desire to learn is supported by a freedom to explore our prepared classroom environment under the guidance of an AMI qualified Montessori teacher. Sai Kung Montessori provides a bilingual, English and Putonghua, curriculum.</p>	
Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
<p>The trained Montessori teacher acts to nurture and guide the children by modelling the use of the different learning materials. She also facilitates free movement within the classroom, promotes the free choice of activities and creates opportunities for the children to apply their newly acquired knowledge to the world around them. In a Montessori classroom, learning takes place within a social environment. There is a three year age mix of children (ages 3-6) peacefully working alongside one another either collaboratively in small groups or individually. The curriculum is child directed, hands on and exploration based with activities that are purposeful and fun.</p>	
Assessment of children's learning experiences	
<p>Each child has their own individual lesson plan and receives either individual or small group lessons. This allows the child to move through the curriculum at their own pace. When they show signs of mastery and readiness they move on to the next lesson. Constant observations of the child are made so a larger picture of their academic, physical, emotional and social development can be made.</p>

<p>Sai Kung Montessori strives to provide a learning environment that optimally meets the needs of each child during their most crucial years of development.
