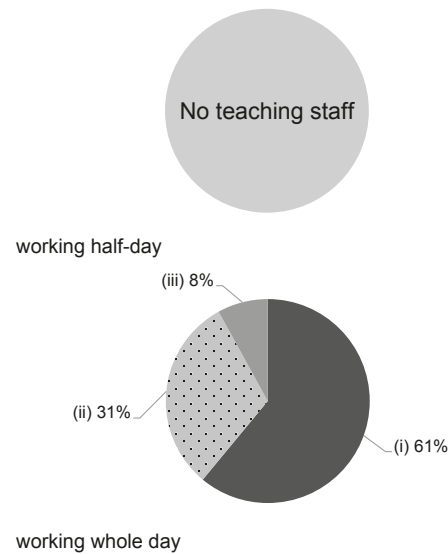

<p>Since 2010, Yan Oi Tong has been developing the "3C" education concept. The core of "3C" education is "Child-centred", which emphasises the autonomy of children. We use diversified activities and DRAMA-centred curriculum to make children learn through fun and practice the following core values: Creativity, Communication, Collaboration; Development, Resilience, Actualization, Mentorship and Attitude.</p> <p>We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>	
Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
<p>We teach through drama, thematic activities, sharing of life experiences, English games, Mandarin story, scientific discovery, physical training, ice skating training, and musical and artistic development.</p>	
Assessment of children's learning experiences	
<p>A continuous observation model is used to observe and record children's learning on a daily basis. Children's development is properly recorded and analysed, and a personal learning portfolio is created for children to regularly collect developmental data to understand their progress and provide appropriate teaching to meet individual needs.</p>

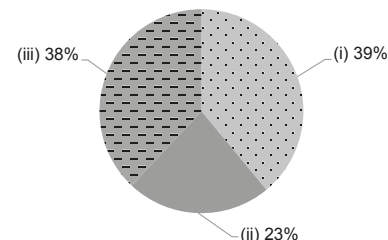

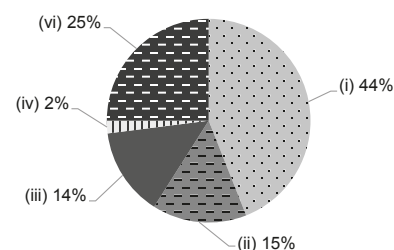
